Building History

Construction began summer 1989 and the lodge opened in May 1990. Additional rooms and facilities were completed summer 1991. A ten room expansion was completed in July 1994 at a total cost of \$7.6 million. A second ten room expansion was completed in May 1995. Conference room space expansion was completed in spring 1996. A third expansion of 16 additional guest rooms was completed in September 1999.
