12 Copper River Princess Wilderness Lodge

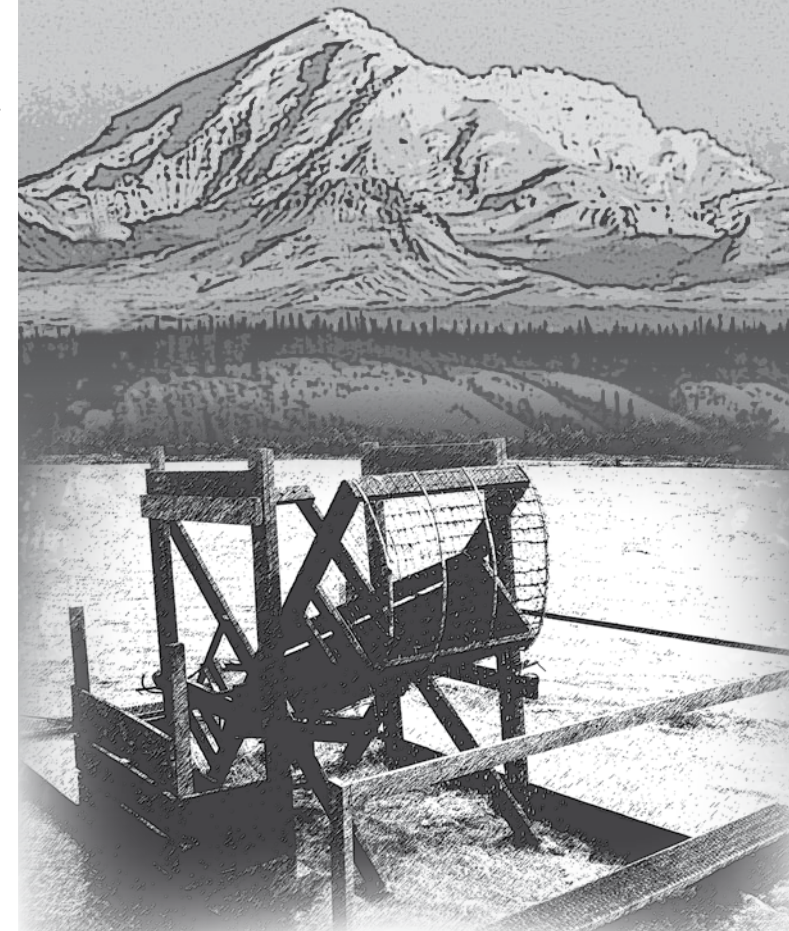

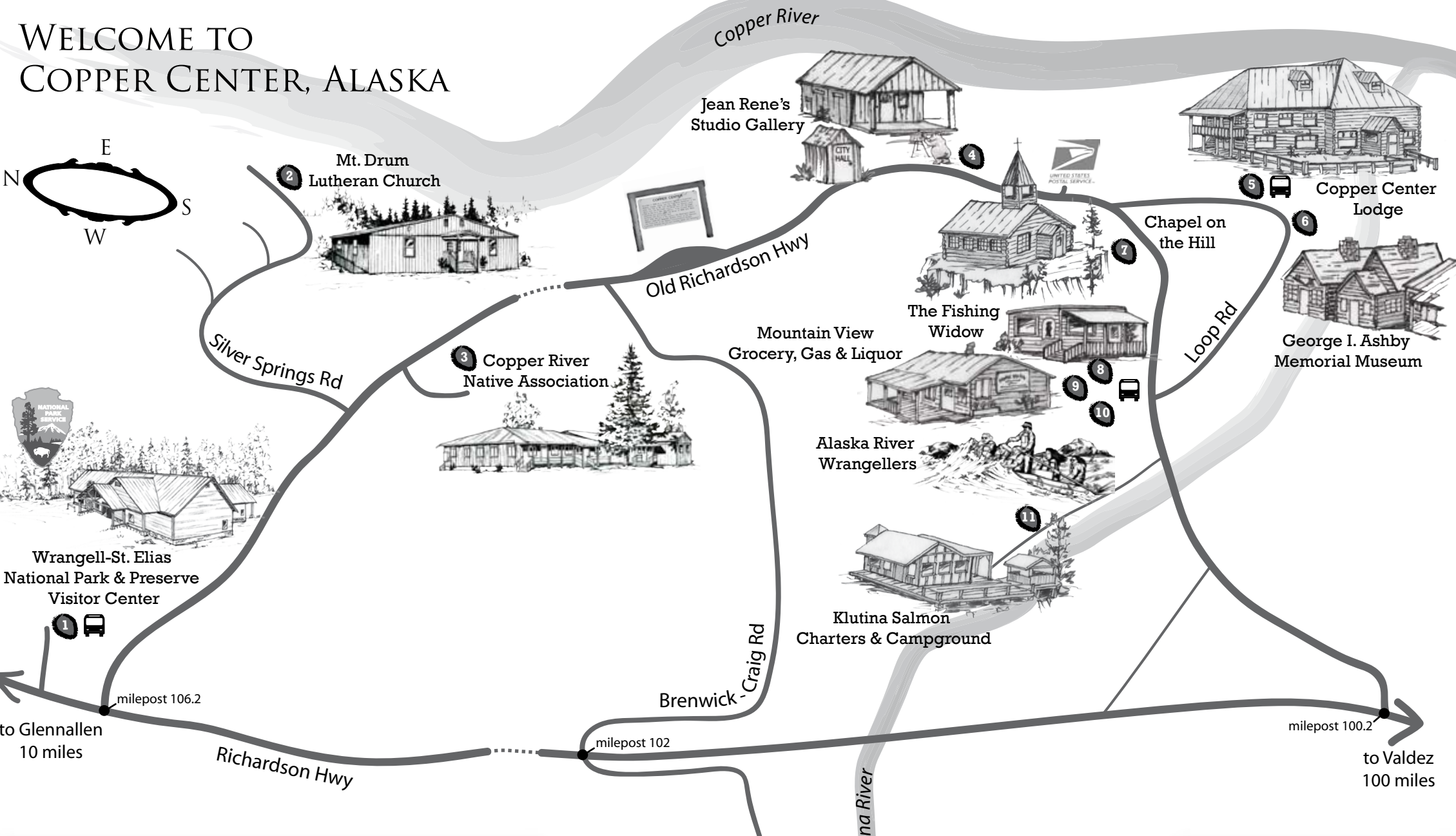
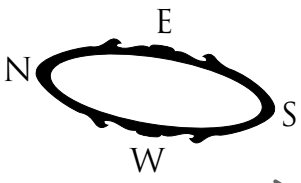
